# **Montgomery County Election Commissioner**

A native of Vancouver Canada, Rick arrived in Clarksville in 1978 and became a U.S. citizen in 1985. He

was recruited for the 1978 start-up of the zinc smelter in Montgomery County and worked at the smelter for 38 years in a number of management positions, including Production Manager and Asset (Maintenance and Engineering) Manager. He was a Tennessee Registered Professional Engineer for 29 years. He retired from Nyrstar in 2016.

Rick is presently President of the Valentine Sevier Chapter of the Sons of the American Revolution, and has traced his lineage back to four American Revolution Patriots, one serving at Valley Forge. He is active in the chapter Color Guard. Gail, his wife of 22 years, is Regent for the local chapter of the Daughters of the American Revolution. Rick also teaches step aerobics at Hilldale Baptist Church's Life Center.

He has a Metallurgical Engineering Degree from the University of British Columbia and a Masters of Business Degree from the Owen School at Vanderbilt University.

Rick served as campaign manager for Carol Rice in her successful run for Tennessee State Senate in 1992, and currently serves on the Montgomery County Election Commission.
