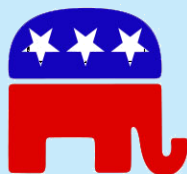

The August 4th General Election will be our opportunity to retain conservative Justices on the Tennessee Supreme Court. Tennessee has six Supreme Court Justices appointed by the governor of Tennessee for an eight-year term. Justice Appointees must run for retention in the August election of even-numbered years.

The three Supreme Court justices, the three Court of Appeals justices, and the four Court of Criminal Appeals justices that are listed on the August ballot have all been appointed by Governor Bill Haslam and

should be retained. They are all Republicans.

Often we voters skip over voting for judicial retentions because we do not usually know their names and they do not get the attention other state and national candidates receive. Equally important to Tennesseans is having conservatives interpreting our laws.

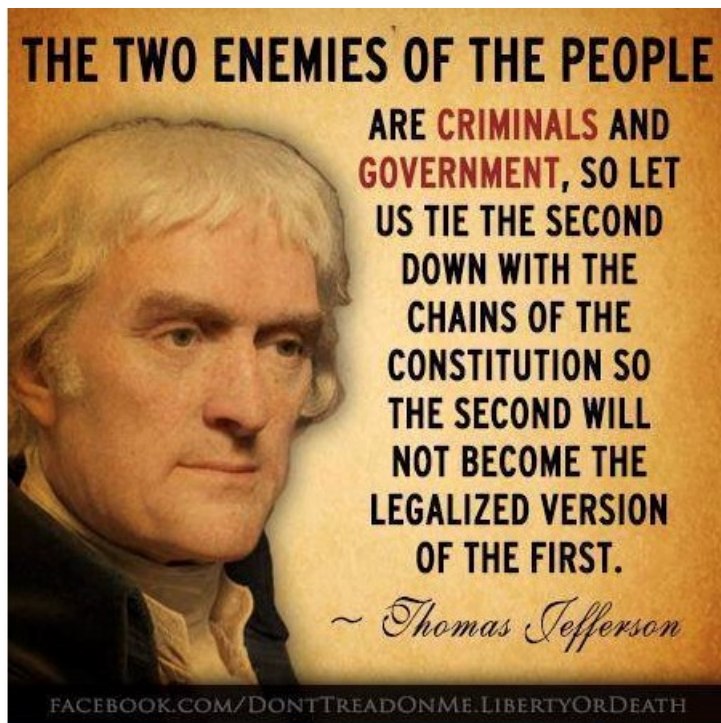

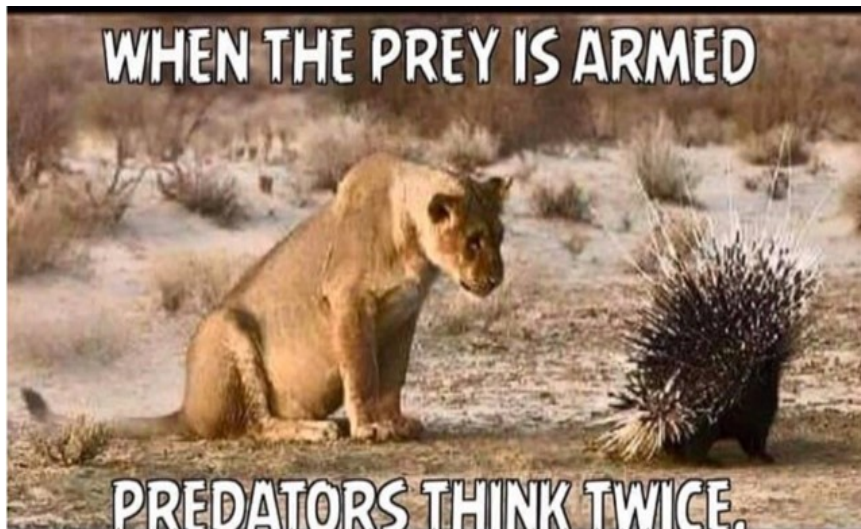
